Subject:- **Environmental Clearance for Construction of 20 Nos. House Type- I (five storey) and 20 Nos. Houses Type – III (five storey) Scheme” located at Sector 25, Panjab University, South Campus, Chandigarh proposed by Panjab University, Chandigarh- delisting thereof.**

I am directed to refer on the subject cited above and to inform you that the committee has received your application vide your letter No.2852/EE-I dated 15.10.2013 for the grant of environmental clearance to the above cited project.

Whereas, some preliminary information were found absent in the application form. Accordingly, the SEAC's vide its letter dated 25.10.2013 (Annexure – 1) had asked to submit information alongwith supporting documents for placing the matter before the SEAC, Chandigarh for its appraisal.

Whereas, No reply was furnished, even after a lapse of 2 ½ months. Then the case was placed before SEAC's in its 21<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 15.01.2014 for its information, wherein it was decided that a reminder may again be issued to the project proponent for furnishing the information asked vide letter dated 25.10.2013 alongwith additional information in regard to the total built-up area of the existing construction before 07.07.2004 , within one month. If, the information did not received within prescribed period the matter will be dealt as per the directions contained in OM dated 30.10.2012 (Annexure- 2) issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests, New Delhi wherein it has been mentioned that:-



- i) All projects where additional information desired has not been submitted even after 6 months of the EAC meeting, should be delisted from the list of pending projects
- ii) For the projects pending between 3-6 months of the EAC meeting for want of information, reminder may be sent seeking information within a month. If the information is not received within this period, even these projects may be de-listed.

Whereas, as per the recommendations of the SEAC passed in its 21<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 15.01.2014, a reminder was issued vide SEAC's letter dated 29.01.2014 (Annexure- 3) for providing the information which was again followed by the reminder dated 02.05.2014 (Annexure- 4).

Whereas, no information was supplied even after a lapse of 6 months of SEAC's meeting held on 15.01.2014.

Whereas, the case was again placed before the SEAC in its 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 13.08.2014 wherein, SEAC has unanimously resolved that the above mentioned project be delisted, in compliance to the directions contained in the OM dated 22.10.2012 issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests, New Delhi, on the ground that the project proponent failed to furnish the information even after 6 months. The project hereby stands delisted.
