The committee has gone through the Form -I/IA alongwith its e and following preliminary observations/deficiencies have been made:-


- As per the Notification dated 01.12.2009 issued by the MoEF, the projects to be located within 10 km of the National Parks Biosphere Reserves, Migratory Corridors or Wild Animal proponent shall submit the map duly authenticated by Warden showing these features vis-a-vis the project location recommendation or comments of the Chief Wildlife Warden. In the absence of such documents the committee desired the proponent to submit a map duly authenticated by Chief Wildlife Warden.





  4. The project proponent may be asked to submit the existing and proposed plantation detail.


It was unanimously resolved to ask the project proponent to complete the application enabling the SEAC to consider the case for environmental clearance.






